HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

Ross MacArthur Contractor Ltd (RMCL) is committed to ensuring the highest standards in Health and Safety management, as reasonably practical. We operate and maintain an Occupational Health & Safety Management System (OH&S) compliant with ISO 45001:2018 standards.

RMCL Management is committed to:

- 1. Comply with all relevant OH&S legislation, standards, and other industry requirements.
- 2. Provide a framework for setting OH&S objectives.
- 3. Prevent work-related injuries & illness via proactive risk management and implementation of effective control measures.
- 4. Continually improve our OH&S management system and performance by identifying/ mitigating hazards and risks associated with our activities.
- 5. Provide a safe place of work for workers, safe access/egress to their place of working. Maintain a safe working environment for handling, transport and storage of items hazardous to health.
- 6. Ensuring that all workers are aware of their OH&S responsibilities by information, supervision instruction. Are provided with necessary training & resources to carry out their duties safely to ensure competent for the job, without putting themselves & others at risk by actions/omissions.

- 11. Provision of Emergency Procedures for fire or other similar risks. Investigate incidents & nearmisses to identify root causes and corrective actions to prevent recurrence.
- 12. Regularly review & update of the OH&S policy to reflect changes in legislation, industry standards, and organizational priorities.
- 13. Promote workforce consultation, involvement and feedback to identify areas for improvement and collectively enhance the effectiveness of the OH&S management system.
